# TOURNAMENT EVENTS AND FORMAT

1. **BOYS SINGLES EVENT** - all age divisions.  
**GIRLS SINGLES EVENT** - all age divisions.

2. **BOYS DOUBLES EVENT** - all age divisions.  
**GIRLS DOUBLES EVENT** - all age divisions.

**MIXED DOUBLES** will bowl as boys doubles.

3. **FOUR PERSON TEAM EVENT**

The team can be any line up with a maximum of 15 points made up as follows :

PEEWEE	1 POINT
BANTAM	1 POINT
JUNIOR	2 POINTS
INTERMEDIATE	3 POINTS
SENIOR	4 POINTS
GRADUATE	5 POINTS
UNDER 21	5 POINTS

4. **ALL EVENTS**

All bowlers entering the three events will automatically be entered in the All Events.

5. **SCORING**

Handicap = 75% of the difference between average and 200. (See Rule 10)

6. **BOWLING ORDER**

Bowlers will bowl in the order declared on the Entry Form in both singles, doubles & scratch and handicap sections.

7. **ENTRY FEE**

The Entry Fee will be £12.50 per bowler, per event. This sum includes £8.10 lineage, £1 contribution to the NAYBC International Team Fund, 90p expenses and £2.50 Prize Fund per event. All prize fund returned 100% as trophies.

<b>INTERMEDIATE</b>	Under 14 years at 31 <sup>st</sup> August 2014	(DOB from 01/09/2000 to 31/08/2002)
<b>SENIOR</b>	Under 16 years at 31 <sup>st</sup> August 2014	(DOB from 01/09/1998 to 31/08/2000)
<b>GRADUATE</b>	Under 18 Years at 31 <sup>st</sup> August 2014	(DOB from 01/09/1996 to 31/08/1998)
<b>UNDER 21</b>	Under 21 Years at 31 <sup>st</sup> August 2015	(DOB from 01/09/1994 to 31/08/1996)

## TOURNAMENT RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. The tournament will be both a JTE and BTBA Tour event. Tournament and general playing rules of the BTBA will govern this tournament, together with the following Special Rules and Conditions.
2. Closing date for entries is the 15<sup>th</sup> December 2014 and any incomplete entries will not be squadded until **all** information is supplied. Partial entries will go to the back of the queue. **Entry fees will not be refunded once players have been squadded.**
3. Registration will be 30 minutes prior to bowling **and subject to no more than two alterations. More than two alterations must be submitted at least 72 hours prior to bowling.** If all bowlers are present and registered then bowling may commence earlier than the published squad times. Tardy players will commence play at the frame in progress as directed by the Tournament Manager.
4. Competitors who, in the opinion of the Tournament Manager/Committee are not dressed in the correct bowling attire in the playing area will not be permitted to bowl. Shirts must bear the name of the player's YBC. Sponsors details may be included, except for alcoholic or tobacco products. Casual shorts or denim clothing of any description will not be permitted, however, skirts, skorts and tailored shorts will be permitted.
5. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages anywhere in the centre during the tournament. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification of the individual from the tournament. Profane language or abuse of bowling equipment or machinery may also result in disqualification. Any disqualification may result in the loss of scores and awards. Any individual so disqualified will be reported to the BTBA for consideration of disciplinary proceedings.
6. Protests of any nature must be lodged by the YBC registered official/player with the Tournament Manager within 30 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing before the presentation commences. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Only tournament officials and one licensed instructor/coach for any YBC, are allowed in the seating area, for any event, dressed in correct attire as above.
7. This tournament is open to all members of the BTBA who are under 21 on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2015. Teams from different YBCs and including U21 players will also be accepted as well as YBC teams providing they still meet the maximum 15 points rule. These teams must also fill in a separate entry form with payment to secure a place in the team event. All BTBA cards must be shown at registration, failure to do so will result in a £2 fine.
8. All bowlers need to have completed all of their tournament entry before they will be permitted to become pacers.
9. Handicaps will be based on 75% of the difference between the average and 200. The highest average attained over 15 games must be used, whether junior, adult or merit, and a league standing sheet to verify the average must be included with all entries. An unverified average will result in the players rolling off scratch. The Tournament Manager/Committee reserves the right to accept, re-rate or reject any entry and their decision on all matters including protests and or any other questions shall be final, subject to the right of appeal to the BTBA.
10. No bowler will be able to receive awards for both scratch and handicap in the same event, i.e. Scratch 3<sup>rd</sup> will take precedence over Handicap 1<sup>st</sup>.
11. Perpetual trophies will be awarded to the winning teams in the Scratch and Handicap sections and a trophy for the YBC of the Tournament – defined as the best behaved & presented YBC.
12. In the event of a tie all winners will receive a trophy, with the exception of the perpetual trophies, where the trophy will be shared for the relative period by each YBC/individual.
13. Only food and drink purchased on the premises are to be consumed within the premises.

### Team England Qualification

JTE Ranking points will be awarded for individual top 70 boys and top 70 girls over the first 9 games qualifying scratch scores or final finishing position in the tournament.

**1<sup>st</sup>** place will receive 120 points, **2<sup>nd</sup>** place 110 points, **3<sup>rd</sup>** place 100 points, **4<sup>th</sup>** place 95 points, **5<sup>th</sup>** place 90 points, **6<sup>th</sup>** place 85 points, **7<sup>th</sup>** place 80 points, **8<sup>th</sup>** place 75 points, **9<sup>th</sup>** place 70 points, **10<sup>th</sup>** place 65 points, then **11<sup>th</sup>** place to **70<sup>th</sup>** place 60 points down to 1 point.
